God, today, is looking for people with the attitude that I have a destiny! That means I have a destination and I am going somewhere. I am here to accomplish and achieve a purpose in God. Yes, you will face challenges and opposition. I wish I could tell you that you would never have another test or trial. I wish I could tell you that nothing will ever come against you, but that simply is not true.

We sometimes have the mentality that we're never going to have a challenge, or face opposition if we have faith in God. No, you will never know how much faith you have unless your faith is tested, challenged, or tried. Jesus is the author and finisher of our faith. He was tried, challenged, and his faith was tested but God ministered to him. Jesus was also attacked by the powers of darkness but each time he over-came.

You are a person of destiny! There is a purpose for you being here. There is a reason for you being alive. There is a reason for you being in the body of Christ today. Why? Because you are a person of destiny.

I have found out that just because God has called you to do something doesn't mean that it is going to happen automatically. It's going to happen as you get up by faith, walk out, and do what God said to do. Recently God had me saying this scripture over and over again, "God has not given me the spirit of fear but of power, love, and a sound mind." 2 Timothy 1:7

One of the greatest opposing forces known to man is fear. That's where the devil operates. He attacks your mind with fear, with thoughts of the unknown. Before you were born, God knew that you were a person of destiny. He knew that you were proper and that you were going to follow after Him. He knew you would walk in all of His ways even when others would forsake him. He knew you were going to do what God said do. You were going to accomplish it even in the face of all the opposition. Don't quit, don't give up. Get up and declare God's Word is still just as true today as the day he told them to arise and march into the Promised Land. God knew you were going to have that attitude. That's why he chose you and called you. There are many others that God has called to come but they are waiting to see what happens. They are waiting to see if the dream is going to be fulfilled.

From the beginnings, Moses' life was in danger. He was born on the wrong side of the tracks. He was born in the wrong kingdom. He had the wrong mother and father but he had the right God! That's all you need.

If you've got God on your side, you will arrive at your destination. We are people of destiny. God will grab a hold of you and uphold you in the right hand of His righteousness and He's not going to let you fail. Even when you try to quit, He's going to reach down, get you, and pick you up!

Moses was a person with a destination. He was born with a destiny. The devil had plans for Moses to fail. But Moses had to achieve and reach a desired end for God that he was destined to achieve. He was going to reach the desired end. It wasn't going to happen just because God said it was going to happen. It happened because people began obeying God and walking out the vision. No one, no kingdom, no law could stop him from reaching his destiny or achieving or achieving the plan God had for him. God was on his side!

I like what David said, *"I have been young and now I'm old but I've never seen the righteous forsaken or his seed begging for bread."* (Psalm 37:25)

I remember traveling with a pastor and a board member into Charlotte Douglas International Airport one time in my airplane to attend a meeting. It was one of those turbulent days in the air. You couldn't see the end of the nose of the airplane. It was cloudy and the wind was gusting. You don't want it gusting. You would rather have a hundred-mile an hour wind than a gusting wind means all of a sudden you have a thirty or forty knot wind and then no wind.

Then, you've got to compensate with more power. If you don't have enough airflow over those wings, you are not going to create lift. Anytime the wind quits blowing that means you've got to increase your airspeed. You want to create lift.

We were landing and you couldn't see the nose of the aircraft. I noticed the knuckles of the pastor and staff member had already turned white. They were hanging on. "Where's the runway? Where's the runway? Where's the runway?" they said.

I said, "It's right down there."

“Can you see it?” they asked.

“Yes I can see it,” I answered.

“You’re lying. You can’t see it.”

I answered them, “Yes I can see it because I see something you don’t see. I am looking at an instrument that you’re not looking at and because of that I know where the runway is. We are going to reach our destination.”

They said, “I sure do hope you’re right.”

I told them, “You better not hope I’m right you better thank God I’m right.” You see I was able to see past the storm, because of the aircraft instrument. Yes, there was a storm. Yes the plane was rocking and rolling. The people in the back were wondering if we were going to arrive and reach our destination. I told them, “sit back, buckle your seat belts and hang on. I’m not saying it’s going to be an easy ride. In fact, it’s going to get rougher than it is now. Hang on, don’t abort the aircraft, we are going to reach our destination. I can see something.” That’s what Moses did. He could see something nobody else did. That’s why he could accomplish something that nobody else could accomplish!

If you can see the invisible, you can accomplish the impossible! Look not to those things that you can see but look to those things that are unseen. Things that you see are only temporary, they are going to change. The things that are unseen-they are eternal. The only reason the circumstances are there is to get your attention off of what you are doing.

You see that day in the aircraft I could see something. I was putting my trust in God. I had huge beads of sweat on my head but the people on board were in worse condition than I was. I could see something. By faith, I could see our destination. There is an instrument in my aircraft and all you have to do is believe what the instrument says. It’s called an ILS, an “Instrument Landing System.” It has oscillating hands and side that flows in different directions. All you do is center those hands in the instrument and hang on. They didn’t know but I was seeing something they couldn’t see.

I said, “I am going to fly this plane and we’re going to go there. Just hang on. If I keep the crosshairs centered on this little dot in the middle of this thing then we’re going to make the runway.”

I asked them, “Can’t you see the runway?”

“No, no, we can’t see it!” they responded.

I told them, “There it is, right there on this instrument. That little dot is the runway. I’m not looking out there because I can’t see out there. I’m looking right here at this ILS and keeping it centered.”

Many of you are looking way out yonder but you need to look at the Word of God. That’s your ILS. Center the crosshairs on the Word of God. Put it in your heart, put it in your mouth and say, “Bless God I’m going to reach my destination. I’m not going to stop, I’m not going to quit, and I’m not going to give up! I’m going to center my faith on the Word of God.” That day the wind was gusting 30 to 40 miles per hour. I mean from 0 to 30 and back down. We were just flopping everywhere. The big boys in the commercial aircraft were even flopping back and forth. The people with me said, “Are we going to make it?”

I said, “Yes! We are going to make it. God has not given me a spirit of fear, but a spirit of power, love, and a sound mind.” If you are one who constantly saying God’s

Word is not going to work, then you are never going to reach your destination. You're never going to reach your desired end. I centered those crosshairs and I hung on. Yes it rocked and rolled, rocked and rolled and at a minimum decent at altitude (MDA), suddenly, I busted out of the clouds. You've never seen such a beautiful sight in all your life! We arrived there because I saw something that they could not see. That's what I looked at, I looked at the invisible to accomplish the impossible. All I had to do was trust instrument on the aircraft and follow it to the runway. You must trust God's Word!

Moses did that also. He was a person of destiny. Verse 23 of Hebrews Chapter 11 says, *By faith Moses, when he was born, he was hid three months of his parents because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.* They were going to obey God regardless what anybody said. Verse 24-27, *By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasure of sin for a season; Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward. By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king, for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.*

What caused him to endure? What caused him to accomplish his task? What caused him to fulfill his destiny? Fore he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

God is on our side-we cannot fail! You will accomplish what God called you to accomplish. You will achieve what God said for you to achieve. You will endure if you see him that is invisible, you can accomplish the impossible.

I remember another incident I had in another airplane. I was in a Cherokee 180 and every airplane has what they call a curtain crosswind component landing capability, which means there's only so much wind that can be blowing across the runway that you can compensate for in this aircraft to make it land on that runway without it blowing you off the runway. It's all based on size, weight, and capabilities of the aircraft. I was going in and had a crosswind component of about 15 to 20 knots. I was in Ohio and the crosswind at the runway I needed to land on was a 35 knots. It was a direct crosswind. I decided to fly up high and that would give me an indication of what it's going to be like down there. So I got up centerline and I started flying sideways into the wind. It blew me way off the runway. I thought, *ii will be almost impossible to put this airplane on that airport down there.* The crosswind component is too great; I cannot compensate any more. This is all this aircraft is designed to do.

I said, "Lord you know I've got to preach down there. Lord I don't want to try you. I know it's not right to try you, but Lord, me and you have got to put this airplane down there. Father, I'm going to believe that you are with me and you're going to help me accomplish this task! There are people down there waiting on me." So, I made a couple of passes up high above the runway, nor real high, about 1,000 feet. There's only one way I can make this aircraft go down there. I've got to bounce the airplane in. In the natural, it seemed there was no way that it could be accomplished. I prayed, "Father you told me to do this. You told me to learn how to fly an airplane. You're the one that said this is my destiny to do this. You called me to do it. I said Father you've got to help me. I've never missed a meeting because of weather in an aircraft. I've got to get down there."

The Lord said, "do it the way you thought to do it but don't start at the end of the runway." The Lord's smart! I asked why. "Because there are no trees south or north of

the airport at the end, but look middle ways and you've got trees on both sides. When you get below that tree line those trees are going to help block the wind." God is smart; I wonder where He got his pilot license? If you will trust him who is invisible, he may tell you to do it a little different way. That's when you follow the leading of the Holy Spirit.

I flew out about a mile to approach the airport. I had the throttle to the firewall. The plane was doing all it could do. It was shuttering and being tossed about. I flew it down to the runway. I was trying to stay on the runway centerline just above it. The wind was trying to blow me off. I just kept going and decided I was going to have to just go straight down at it. So I pulled back up and got above the tree line. When I got it up to the trees, I shot the nose down. When I shot the nose down the wind subsided just a little bit and when it did I flew right into the wind and sat it down and skidded side ways and it bounced me back up. Skidded again, bounced down, bounced up, bounced down, bounced up, the wind kept knocking me down.

The people that were on the ground thought I was putting on a show for them! I wanted to get out and whip them because I wanted them praying, not just standing there looking!! I wanted someone to endure seeing him that's invisible, because I needed God then. Finally, I got it glued down on the runway. But now I'm sitting down at the end because I was halfway when I started. At the end there's a fence so when I got down there close to the fence I took a hard left and turned a one-eighty and started back the other way. I made it successfully!

Just because you're a person of destiny does not mean that you are not going to have opposition. If you'll begin to endure as seeing Him who is invisible you'll always fulfill your destiny. God will help you! You're going to have the enemy coming, but I'm here to tell you that God has a plan for you to accomplish. You're a person with a destiny. Pull yourself together and say, "I'm going to trust in the Lord with all my heart and lean not unto my own understanding in all my ways I will acknowledge him and he's going to direct my path." You will see the will of God accomplished in Jesus name! God is on your side. Do it God's way. God is going to take those people that can see the invisible and accomplish the impossible with them.
